## **CURRENT DIOCESAN REQUIRED PRECAUTIONS**

- Any individual (adult or child) must wear a mask when indoors, regardless of vaccination status.
- Those who are fully vaccinated are not required to wear masks outdoors. Any individual may choose to wear a mask at any time, and should not be questioned about their reasons for doing so.
- Christ Church is not required to verify the vaccination status of anyone entering the church property or worshipping with the congregation, except for limited ministries.
- Communion shall continue to be offered in one kind only. The common cup is not yet authorized in this diocese.
- Stay Home if you do not feel well or showing symptoms of the COVID-19 virus
